Information:

As part of creating a safer biking network, we are proposing to paint bike lanes between the existing kerbside parking and the traffic lanes on both sections of Yule Street – between the Leonie Gill Pathway and Coutts Street, and between Coutts Street and Rongotai Road.

The street provides a quiet connection between the Leonie Gill Pathway and Rongotai Road, where safer bike lanes are also proposed. From Rongotai Road, planned connections include improved facilities through to Newtown via Crawford Road, as well as the existing pathway to Kemp Street and the ASB Sports Centre.

There has been a long process to get to this point, including several opportunities to provide feedback and attend open days. Along with wider community input, we worked closely with the Kilbirnie community working group this year to look at all the options. Following public feedback in September, we have been refining this design.

This project, and others in the final stages of development, will go a long way towards creating a connected bike network for the east. Other projects in Kilbirnie and Miramar have been planned to complement these ones and add to the local network. They will either be progressed next year, or when funding allows.

The projects are all part of the city's cycleways programme, which is being planned and delivered in partnership with the Government and NZ Transport Agency. Our goal is to gradually develop a connected citywide network with facilities that will be safer and more appealing to less confident riders.

Proposed changes

As with Te Whiti Street, which already has traffic-side painted bike lanes, the proposed new lanes on Yule Street are considered appropriate for a quiet route like this. The painted lanes will help signal to drivers that people on bikes may be using the street, and where they are most likely to be riding.

In this quiet street, painted bike lanes between the parked cars and traffic should be enough to make this part of the planned network safer and more appealing for less confident riders. It will provide a clear connection between the Leonie Gill Pathway and the proposed Rongotai Road cycleway.

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Parking will remain as it is now, apart from at the intersection of Rongotai Road where two car parking spaces will need to be removed - one on each side of the street - to make the intersection safer.

The width of the traffic lane will be altered to be 5.9m wide between Coutts Street and Leonie Gill Pathway, and 5.7m wide between Coutts Street and Rongotai Road.


